Spring 2019 GFCMSU Welding and Fabrication Scholarship Application Instructions

The Welding and Fabrication Scholarship Program at Great Falls College MSU centralizes multiple donor funded scholarships as available into a single application form. The GFCMSU Welding and Fabrication Scholarships are \$1000 scholarships unless otherwise specified. The number of scholarships awarded will be based on available funding. The awards will be disbursed in two equal segments, one for each semester (Spring and Summer). Each semester, upon verification after the 15th day of class that the recipients are enrolled in the specified course work for Welding program, the scholarship will be applied to the student account for payment toward tuition, fees, books, and supplies. To receive the second semester portion of the scholarship, recipients must maintain satisfactory academic progress and hold a 2.5 cumulative G.P.A at Great Falls College MSU.

ELIGIBILITY The **GFC MSU Welding and Fabrication Scholarship** award recognizes students who:

- Will be enrolled at Great Falls College MSU as a regular student in the Welding program
- Possess and maintain a 2.5 GPA or above
- Are a Montana Resident (except for ADF Welding Scholarship)
- Demonstrate their personal desire to become a skilled welder through the GFC MSU welding program
- Meet additional requirements as determined by each available scholarship. (see below)

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

- The **ADF Welding Scholarship** will award up to two (2) \$1000 scholarships. May be enrolled as a regular student or a Dual Enrollment student in the Welding CAS or AAS program. Must be enrolled full time (12 or more credits per term).

APPLICATION PACKET REQUIREMENTS:

1. **Scholarship Application:** Complete the application form in its entirety. (see page two)
2. **Personal Statement:** One concise statement in paragraph format summarizing why you are pursuing a career in Welding and Fabrication, and how you will reach your goals. Include obstacles to overcome, short and long-term goals, statement of financial need, and any other information you wish to share. Please limit to no more than one page.
3. **Letter of Recommendation:** Submit ONE letter from an instructor or from a personal reference, such as an employer, pastor, supervisor, etc. The letter must include the name, place of employment, position, and contact information of person making recommendation.
4. **Current Unofficial Transcripts:** New freshmen must submit a current high school transcript. Transfer students must submit the most recent college transcript. Continuing GFC students who have **completed** at least one term at Great Falls College MSU do not need to submit transcripts.
